The Balancing Crew is responsible for checking bikes in the field, carrying out field repairs, and re-balancing bikes between the stations. Balancing Crew members and Support Crew are expected to be detail oriented and excited to learn about bike share and new technologies. You will be working partially outside and often engaging with customers. As such, an approachable and friendly personality is expected from the balancing crew at all times. Each team member can expect to work on a variety of tasks related to the overall program health and long term goals.

We are seeking new team members for the permanent part-time work. We are open 7 days a week, and with this being the case, evening and weekend work should be expected as part of any schedule.
